



Commercial Operation Start-up of São Manoel HPP's Fourth Generation Unit

São Paulo, April 26th, 2018 – EDP Energias do Brasil S.A. (“EDP” or “Company”) (B3: ENBR3) informs its shareholders and the market in general that the Empresa de Energia São Manoel (“São Manoel HPP”) was authorized today by the National Electric Energy Agency (“ANEEL”) to begin the commercial operation of its Fourth Generation Unit with Installed Capacity of 175 MW (Physical Guarantee of 57.1 average MW).

With the Declaration of Commercial Operation (DCO) of this Unit, São Manoel HPP is fully operational and its CCEAR contractual obligations (Energy Commercialization in a Regulated Environment) becomes effective as of today.

São Manoel HPP is located on the Teles Pires River in the state divide between Mato Grosso and Pará, with 700 MW of Installed Capacity and 424.5 average MW of Physical Guarantee.

São Manoel HPP is a partnership between EDP Energias do Brasil, CTG and Furnas Centrais Elétrica S.A., each with a one-third stake in the project.
