



PARTIAL ENTRY INTO COMMERCIAL OPERATION – MA II TRANSMISSION LINE

São Paulo, January 07th, 2020 - EDP - Energias do Brasil S.A. ("EDP" or "Company") (B3: ENBR3) informs its shareholders and the market in general that, on January 04th, 2020, the National Electric System Operator ("ONS") issued the term related to the beginning of the commercial operation for one out of two transmission lines and one substation Chapadinha II for EDP Transmissão MA II S.A. ("EDP Transmissão MA II").

The start of operations is 19 months ahead of ANEEL's schedule and 14 months ahead of the assumption adopted by the Company in the auction, representing a Partial Annual Revenue (RAP) of R\$ 17.0 million¹, which corresponds to 51% of total Annual Revenue.

EDP Transmission MA II, acquired in the 1st phase of the auction for Concession of the Electric Energy Transmission Public Service No. 05/2016², consists of a 203 km transmission line divided into two lines of 230 kV (Coelho Neto and Miranda II), including Chapadinha II substation, in the state of Maranhão.

With around 70% leverage, through a financing with Banco do Nordeste do Brasil S.A. ("BNB"), the beginning of commercial operation represents approximately R\$ 27.0 million in anticipated revenue, surpassing the expected return and NPV metrics in the auction.

The skills evidenced in the construction of hydroelectric projects associated with experience in the Distribution segment were decisive for the successful development of this project, reinforcing the Company's commitment to on-time and on-cost deliveries.
